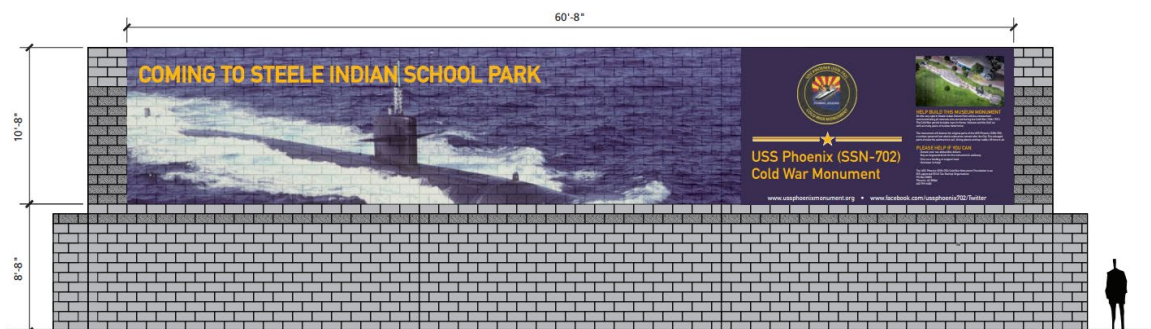

You Are Cordially Invited to Attend a Big Sign Media Reveal in Steele Indian School Park!!

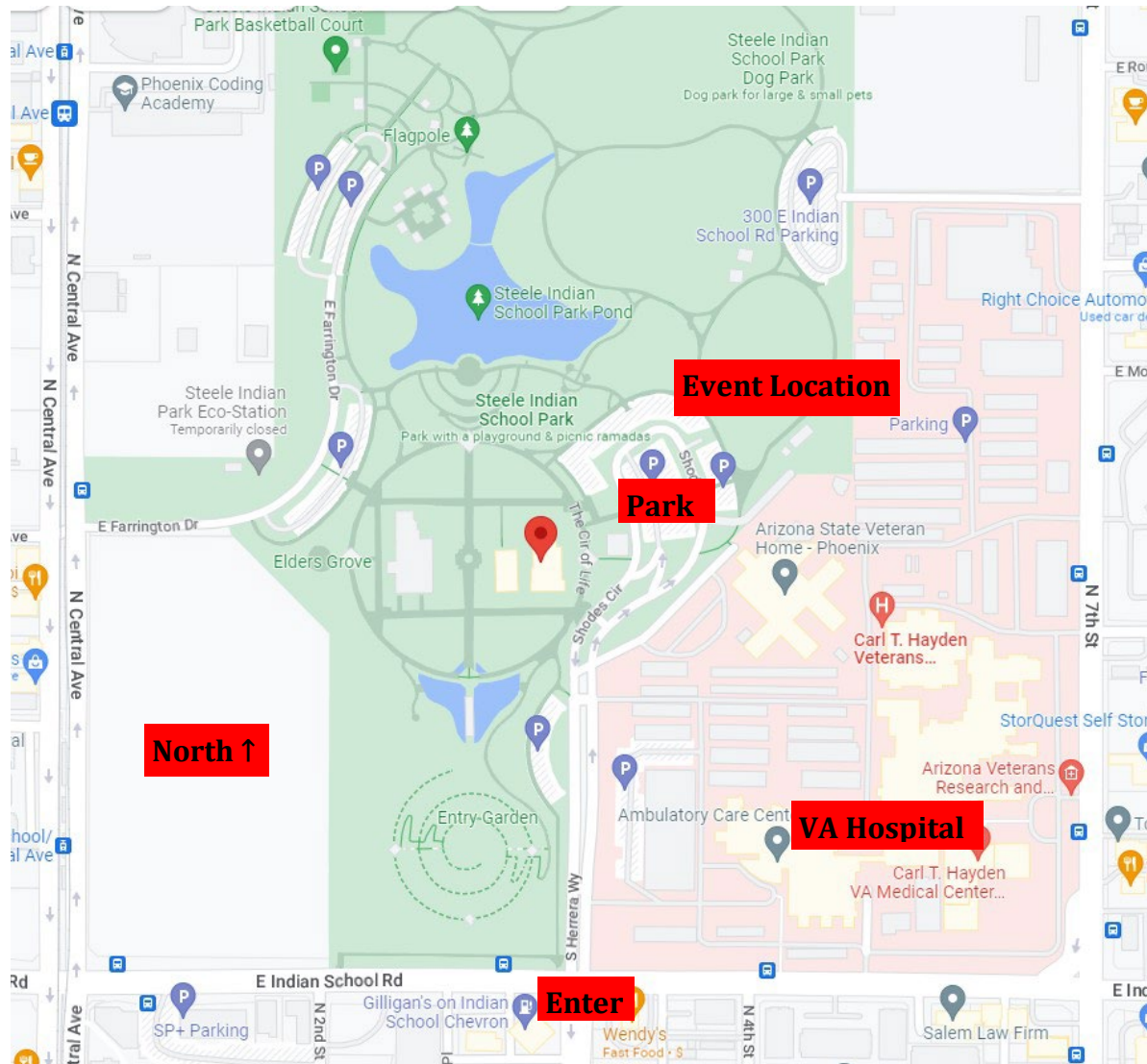
10-11 AM, Tuesday, 11 April 2023 - National Submarine Day!! SAVE THE DATE!!

The monument will use as its centerpiece 65 tons of salvaged parts from the nuclear-powered USS Phoenix (SSN-702), a Los Angeles Class fast attack submarine. On the corner of Indian School and Central
300 E. Indian School Road, Phoenix***



Enter the park from Indian School onto Herrera Way headed north. Stay straight to pass through the gate and then curve around to the right to find an open parking spot. Walk to the event area half a block north.
