Michael E. McLaughlin Rear Admiral, USN (Retired)

Michael graduated from a high school in Mesa Arizona and is a 1981 graduate of the United States Naval Academy where he received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Ocean Engineering. He also has a Masters in Business Administration from the University of Nebraska.

Michael had a 30 year career in the U.S Naval Submarine force. He served aboard several submarines and commanded the submarine USS LA JOLLA (SSN 701). While in the Navy, Michael took on greater leadership roles, including Commodore of Submarine Squadron 11, which was comprised of 6 submarines, and Chief of Staff of Naval Submarine Forces, with a staff of over 200 people and oversight of 22,000 men and women.

Michael rose to the rank of Rear Admiral and in his last job in the Navy, was Commander, Submarine Group TWO, comprising the 25 attack submarines on the East Coast and associated 4000 men and women.

Michael joined Arizona Public Service (APS), the largest electrical utility in Arizona in 2011. He worked at Palo Verde Generating Station, a nuclear power station located west of Phoenix in Tonopah, AZ for 11 years. He retired from APS in 2022 as Vice President Site Services.

Michael and his wife Karen reside in Goodyear, AZ. They have two grown sons.
