ROBERT A. BORGAN, CAPTAIN , USN



Captain Bogan is a native of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. He graduated from Oklahoma State University in 1999 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering. Following graduation, he entered the Navy through Officer Candidate School and then completed initial Nuclear Power training. His first at sea assignment was the USS MICHIGAN (SSBN 727) BLUE. While there, he served as the Reactor Controls Assistant, Electrical Assistant, Main Propulsion Assistant and Assistant Weapons Officer. CAPT Bogan's next assignment was at Commander Submarine Group Seven where he served as a Submarine Watch Officer and then as the Korean Exercises and Plans Officer.

Upon completion of his tour, he left active duty and joined the Inactive Ready Reserve.

After transitioning to a civilian career as a contract engineer at Tinker Air Force Base, CAPT Bogan affiliated with Active Reserves. During his reserve tenure, he served as Officer in Charge of MSV C Champion in support of Operation Enduring Freedom Philippines, and as Officer in Charge of the Operational Support Unit at Naval Operational Support Center Oklahoma City.

CAPT Bogan then served as the Assistant Director for Plans and Policy at Commander Submarine Force Atlantic and then as Operational Support Officer for Commander Submarine Group Eight and the Theater Anti-Submarine Warfare Planning Officer at Commander Task Force 69 in Naples, Italy. Prior to his arrival at NRC Phoenix, he served as the Commanding Officer of Navy Reserve Center Sacramento, the Chief Staff Officer at Navy Reserve Region Readiness and Mobilization Command San Diego, where he completed his Executive Masters in Business from the Naval Postgraduate School, and as the Director of the Commander's Action Group at the Office of the Chief of Navy Reserve.

His awards include the Meritorious Service Medal (three gold stars), the Navy-Marine Corps Commendation Medal, and the Navy-Marine Corps Achievement Medal (three gold stars).
