Because of the increased privacy, members can discuss personal matters, such as the Binnacle List, and can post their own comments.

# HOW I SPENT MY WINTER VACATION

Whenever I travel, I try to remember to "Google" the area I am visiting for Submarine Memorials. This past February, I was in Gilroy, California, the "Garlic Capital of the World," visiting my Brother-In-Law and found a Submarine Memorial in nearby Los Banos, California. The memorial was erected in memory of Louis Robert McMullen, Torpedoman 2nd Class (SS). Louis, a Los Banos resident, was killed in action on November 8, 1944, when the USS Growler (SS-215) was sunk on her eleventh war patrol during a convoy attack in the South China Sea.

The memorial, located on the campus of Merced County Community College, was installed in 2007 by the Fresno Chapter of the U.S. Submarine Veterans of World War II, the Wahoo Base of USSVI, also in Fresno, and the Los Banos Rotary Club.

The memorial mainly consists of a large black granite marker and sixty-five trees in memory of the 65 submarines on Eternal Patrol. Each tree includes a marker with the name of a lost boat and the donor of the marker.



If you travel, try to visit memorials. This memorial is also in the memorial list on the USSVI website. If you need help, I would be glad to help you find others.





Much to my surprise, when I found the tree for the USS Perch (SS-176), the marker noted it had been donated by our Perch Base, USSVI.
