Pictures have been uploaded to the website for the Tale Of Two Cities Parade, the Jack O'Connor obituary and the Rogers Ranch School in Laveen visit that took place earlier today.

With initial help from Steve Leon, the "Perch Base, United States Submarine Veterans Inc." Facebook group was launched. Recent and upcoming events have since been loaded and invitations to join have been sent to the Perch Base membership. A Flash Traffic has been sent to all members to let them know this is now available online. Approximately 29 Perch Base members have joined the group and appear to be using it, based on some event "yes" and "maybe" selections and some "likes" being posted.

During February, there were approximately 2,751 page views on the Perch Base website during 1,313 sessions by 1017 users based on Google Analytics. Approximately 70% of the visits originate in the US, 7% from the United Kingdom and the remaining 23% are widely scattered around the world. Approximately 22% of the visits are from locations within Arizona. The Glossary still accounts for the largest (37%) percentage of the visits and the homepage gets about 26%. There were 176 (6%) visits to the Hot Items page.
