The birthdays for new members were added to the calendar and the Sailing Orders page were updated, the Sailing Orders were updated, Flash Traffics and meeting minutes uploaded, Lost Boat notices and Half Staff notices posted. Similar updates have been maintained on the Perch Base Facebook Group. During June, there were approximately 1,034 page views on the Perch Base website during 469 sessions by 310 users based on Google Analytics.
