Similar updates have been maintained on the Perch Base Facebook Group.

The Rideshare/Carpooling effort now has its first success.

During April, there were approximately 800 page views on the Perch Base website during 407 sessions by 250 users based on Google Analytics. These numbers are typical. Approximately 78% of the sessions originated in the US, 5% from the Canada, 2% from the Japan, and the remainder were widely scattered around the world. Approximately 38% of the U.S. based sessions were from locations in Arizona, which is assumed to come from our membership. 53% of the traffic was to the home page, 24% to the Glossary, 4% to the Sailing Orders page, 3% to the Eternal Patrol page, and 2% to the Annual Picnic photo page.
