Major activity with the website since the last BOD meeting included posting the photos of the Daisy Mountain/Anthem and Black Canyon City Parades, pictures of Jim Andrews' Honor Flight to Washington, DC, Johnny Corbin's award as an honorary plankowner of the USS Oregon (SSN-793,) Don Unser photos visiting a submariner, Don Unser receiving the Silver Anchor Award, posting the new MidWatch to the website and snail-mailing copies to the 6 members without email. Routine updates during the past month included updating the Sailing Orders page, Flash Traffics, base correspondence and meeting minutes uploaded, Lost Boat notices and Half Staff notices posted, and links updated. Similar updates have been maintained on the Perch Base Facebook Page.

During October, there were 802 page views on the Perch Base website during 425 sessions by 310 users based on Google Analytics. These numbers are typical. During the month, approximately 78% of the sessions originated in the US, 5% from China, 2% from the United Kingdom and the remainder were widely scattered around the world. Approximately 18% of the U.S. based sessions were from locations in Arizona, which is assumed to come from our membership. Another 16% of the U.S. based sessions were from Virginia, which is unusual. Most of the traffic (36%) was to the home page and 14% to the Glossary and 12% to the Sailing Orders page.

During October, the Facebook Post Reach (The number of people who saw any of our posts at least once. Reach is different from impressions, which may include multiple views of your posts by the same people.) was 829. The Post Engagements (The number of reactions, comments, shares, and clicks on our posts.) was 364. Our Facebook page had three new Page Likes for a total of 156. These numbers are typical. The top post was Don Unser receiving the Silver Anchor Award.
