Activity with the website since the last BOD meeting included posting National Convention photos, information about the ASU Spouses of Military Veterans Tuition Scholarship and the Karen Emmett Memorial Service photos. Routine updates during the past month included updating the Sailing Orders page, Flash Traffics, base

correspondence and meeting minutes uploaded, Lost Boat notices and Half Staff notices posted, and links updated. Similar updates have been maintained on the Perch Base Facebook Page.

During August, there were 3,818 page views on the Perch Base website during 1,886 visits by 1,344 users based on Awstats. These numbers are typical. During the month, approximately 71% of the sessions originated in the US, 5% each from China, 3% each from Germany, Panama and Russia, and the remainder were widely scattered around the world. Most of the traffic was to the home page (48%), followed by the Glossary (6%), and the Sailing Orders and National Convention pages (3% each).

During August, the Facebook Post Reach (The number of people who saw any of our posts at least once. Reach is different from impressions, which may include multiple views of your posts by the same people.) was 183. The Facebook Post Engagement (The number of reactions, comments, shares, and clicks on your posts) was 59. Our Facebook page had 1 new Page Likes for a total of 174 and 4 new Follows for a total of 198 Followers. These numbers are typical. The top post was "USSVI NATIONAL CONVENTION August 28 - September 2, 2023. About 35 Perch Base Submarine Veterans and family members attended the 2023 . . ." with 44 Post Impressions, a Post Reach of 45, and a Post Engagement of 12.
