- 3. It was reported that the Arizona Memorial grounds had not been properly maintained since the City of Phoenix took responsibility for maintenance from the AZ Secretary of State's office. Once the Secretary of State was notified, the grounds were cleaned and fixed up. If you see something, report it.
- 4. Chris Gahan reported that the VA has established a new support clinic for the blind/vision impaired members at the VA Clinic on 32nd St in Phoenix and that UAV Phoenix has opened a new shelter facility that prioritizes homeless vets and provides additional social services to vets.
